Construction at The William Henry Smith School & Sixth Form







Intent

At The William Henry Smith School & Sixth Form, it will be the intention to foster in the students a desire to study Construction and deepen their knowledge and understanding of the industry and the world of work.

Students who choose construction as part of their pathway will work towards a City and Guilds Entry Level 3 Award or Certificate.



Implementation

Our students will get the opportunity to brick lay, complete joinery and plumbing projects, paint and decorate and complete projects around school including, plastering, paving areas and building decked areas. They will also visit building sites and meet employers and employees that work in the Construction Industry. Students will visit Colleges and attend taster sessions in the different disciplines of Construction and will evidence work through assessments and the completion of worksheets for evidence; Tutors will quality assess qualifications.

Impact

Any student from year 9, who show an interest, will be provided with learning opportunities in Construction.

Students will be able to question ideas and reflect on knowledge/skills and learn to work collaboratively and practically.

Most students will achieve Entry Level 3 In Construction.

Some students will achieve an Entry Level 3 Certificate qualification.

Students will retain knowledge and practical skills that is pertinent to Construction and the building environment with a real-life context.

Some students will use their skills and knowledge to study at a higher level at college post 16.
