Hospitality at The William Henry Smith School & Sixth Form







Intent

At The William Henry Smith School & Sixth Form, it will be the intention to foster in the students a desire to study Hospitality and deepen their knowledge and understanding of the industry and the world of work.

Students who choose Hospitality as part of their pathway will work towards a City and Guilds Entry Level 3 Award or Certificate in an Introduction to the Hospitality Industry.



Our students will have the opportunity to learn about the Hospitality Industry and Customer Service; they will learn about food preparation, cooking, essential knife skills, cleaning and storage, healthy eating, serving food and drink, and using kitchen equipment.

Our students will have the opportunity to prepare food in the school's industrial kitchen and work alongside a professional chef. They will also visit hospitality establishments and meet employers/employees that work in the industry.

There will be opportunities for students to work in school jobs with the catering team and in reception.

Our students will visit colleges and attend taster sessions in the different disciplines of Hospitality and evidence work through practical assessments and complete workbooks for evidence.

Impact

Any student from year 9, who shows an interest, will be provided with learning opportunities in Hospitality.

Students will be able to question ideas and reflect on knowledge/skills.

Students will work collaboratively and practically.

Students will retain knowledge and practical skills that is pertinent to the Hospitality Industry with a real-life context

Most students will achieve Entry Level 3 In Hospitality.

Some students will achieve an Entry Level 3 Certificate qualification.

Some students will use their skills and knowledge to study at a higher level at college or post 16.
